0	Few clouds
1	Partly cloudy (scattered) or variable sky
2	Cloudy (broken) or overcast
4	Fog or smoke

Wind Code	Wind Speed (mph)	Description
0	<1	CALM: smoke rises vertically
1	1-3	LIGHT AIR: rising smoke drifts, weather vane inactive
2	4-7	LIGHT BREEZE: leaves rustle, can feel wind on face
3	8-12	GENTLE BREEZE: leaves and twigs in constant motion, small flags extend
4	13-18	MODERATE BREEZE: moves small branches, raises dust and loose paper ( <b>too windy to monitor</b> )
5	19-24	FRESH BREEZE: small trees in leaf begin to sway ( <b>way too windy to monitor</b> )
